

**Senior Scholarships**  
**January 25, 2010**

1. The **Orangeburg Touchdown Club** is now offering a \$1000 scholarship for a 2010 graduating senior. The TRMC Foundation funds this one-year non-renewable scholarship. The **deadline** for the Scholarship Committee to **RECEIVE** your complete package is **Friday, January 29, by 5PM!** This **means the packet should be mailed NO LATER than Thursday, January 28,** before the last mail leaves your post office! If you are interested in applying for this scholarship, please **come by ASAP for an application.** An applicant **must have 3 letters of recommendation**, including an administrator, a teacher, and a community leader (one from each). Notify your 3 recommenders ASAP so that each one will have a sufficient amount of time to prepare a letter for you!
2. **Pilot Club of Orangeburg Scholarship** applications are now in Guidance. The **deadline** to return this completed app package is **March 31.** You will find very specific instructions within the application packet. This scholarship also requires specific letters of recommendation.
3. **Columbia College is offering Developing Women Scholar-Leaders Scholarships** to enrollees of Columbia College majoring in chemistry, mathematics, or computer and information science. Applications with instructions can be picked up in guidance. This postmark **deadline** is **February 15.**
4. To apply for a **Best Buy scholarship**, go online to [www.bestbuy.com/scholarships](http://www.bestbuy.com/scholarships). One thousand scholarships of \$1000 each will be awarded. The **deadline** for submission is **February 15.** The optimum student for this scholarship is one with solid grades and who is involved in volunteer community service or possesses work experience.
