

Senior Scholarships and Announcements

1. The **AXA Achievement Scholarship** and the **AXA Achievement Community Scholarship**, scholarships in association w/ US News and World Report, are now available at their website, www.axa-achievement.com. See it for more details and to apply. For the first scholarship listed above the **deadline is Dec.1**, each is worth between \$10,000 and \$25,000, and each state has at least one winner. The community scholarship will award up to 375 winners, each is worth \$2000, and its **deadline is Feb.1**.
2. **Reminder to those who intend to apply for the Coca-Cola Scholars scholarship:** The **deadline is October 31st** to apply online. For details, see the OPS website and/or your email doc dated 9/26/11. This is big scholarship dollars if you are one of the multiple winners!!!
3. The **Horatio Alger National and State Scholarship** opportunity is open to applicants online now, at www.horatioalger.org/scholarships. The **deadline to apply is October 30th**! Qualifications, among others, are to be involved in community and co-curricular activities; be a US citizen; have critical financial need, specifically preferring no more than \$50,000 adjusted gross income per family (although explanations if more will be accepted).
4. Children of those who are **employed at Sacannah River Nuclear Solutions** are invited to apply for one of the fifteen \$3000 scholarships. Employees may request applications by calling Edith Hughes at 803-952-8210. Students applying should take the SAT Reasoning Test and three SAT Subject Tests (test choice is up to student) **no later than the January 28** test date. Students should request during registration that the test scores be sent to # 6213 recipient.
5. Any student who is **interested in attending Davidson** should notify Mrs. Craft in Guidance **no later than Monday, November 7**. There are scholarships available but our guidance office must nominate students in order for he/she to be eligible.
6. The **Kittie Moss Fairey Educational Scholarship Program** is now open for applications. You may apply online at www.csascholars.org. To qualify, you must: have at least a 3.0 cum. GPA on a 4.0 scale; have a 1800 SAT (all 3 tests) or 26 ACT composite; household adjusted gross income of \$40,000 or less; and attend a 4-year accredited college in SC upon graduation. The **deadline** for submission is **November 21st**.
7. The **SC Junior Golf Foundation Scholarship Program** online site, www.scholarshipprograms.org, is now available for applicants. The **deadline is November 21st**. Qualifications are as follows: current cum GPA of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale; have a competitive or recreational interest in golf; and attend a 4-year accredited college in SC upon graduation.
