Thank you so much for entrusting your child's educational advancements with us. Orangeburg Preparatory Schools, Inc. continues to strive for excellence in all endeavors. Our faculty and staff work diligently towards the goal of providing a quality education to our children.

In order to plan and budget correctly, a commitment from parents must be made. We must know the number of children who will be attending Orangeburg Prep in the upcoming 2011-2012 school year. Your involvement in this process is of utmost importance.

Please read over the enclosed contract. **As a binding document**, this contract will allow the Board of Directors and the administration to make decisions for the upcoming year. Please return the contract with the building fee attached if you have not satisfied your five-year commitment (see following paragraph). Class sizes and salaries for the entire year are set based on the number of returned contracts. Because so many decisions are based on these contracts, be very mindful when signing. If for some reason the contract needs to be broken, there is a **cancellation fee**. We will set class sizes based on the contracts returned by Friday, March 11, 2011. If a contract is returned after March 11th, a registration fee of \$150 plus the appropriate building fee must accompany the contract.

Also, please note that if your child has been at OPS for five consecutive years, you have met the \$500 building fee requirement. As a result, you will not have to send \$100 to accompany the contract. If you have not paid this fee for five years, you will need to return \$100 along with your child's contract. If you have any doubts, please contact our Business Office.

As always, our goal is to help prepare your child for success in college and in adult life. We have made large investments in recent years in technology, buildings, and capital improvements. We feel that the success of our graduates is a reflection of the fine job that our staff is doing. Rest assured, we are constantly looking to improve the learning experience.

Admission to Orangeburg Preparatory Schools, Inc. is contingent upon successful testing, interview, and satisfactory records from previous school(s). Orangeburg Preparatory Schools, Inc. admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin.

This contract is subject to the following conditions:

1. I understand the school has the right (1) to determine the class, the homeroom, and the work level to which the child shall be assigned; (2) to suspend or expel the child for any disciplinary reason or cause and the school shall be the sole judge of the sufficiency of such reason or cause.
2. I understand that the child shall be subject to and in conformity with the rules as set forth in the Orangeburg Preparatory Schools, Inc., handbook and any other rules adopted by the school.

Financial obligation:

1. I will pay the sum per year for each child's tuition, payable in monthly or quarterly installments beginning June 1st. Subsequent payments are due on the first day of each month or quarter. If paying quarterly, the due dates are the first of June, September, December, and March.
2. I will pay a service charge of \$10 per month on all accounts 20 days past due unless other financial arrangements are approved. The monthly payment must be received (not post-marked) in the lower or upper campus office by the 20th of each month to avoid service charges.
3. I understand that my obligation to pay the charges for the full academic year is unconditional. I also understand that upon a breach of this contract, the school reserves the right to commence a collection action for the full amount due, plus collection costs and reasonable attorney's fees, if applicable, notwithstanding subsequent absences, withdrawal, or dismissal from school of the above student. However, if a child is withdrawn from school or a request for cancellation of contract is made, no collection efforts for the balance will be commenced if the account is brought current and a \$500.00 cancellation fee is paid within thirty (30) days of the student's withdrawal or cancellation request. This contract is binding in its entirety.
