

ORANGEBURG PREP'S LOWER CAMPUS' SUPPLY LIST 2011 — 2012

PRESCHOOL

Supplies for preschoolers: Two 8 count packages of Crayola crayons, an eight count package of classic colored markers, a composition notebook, two large glue sticks, one package of No. 2 pencils, one bottle of Elmer's glue, one dry erase marker (black), one box of Kleenex tissues, two rolls of paper towels, two packages of anti-bacterial wipes, one box of seven ounce Dixie cups, one package of gallon sized Ziploc bags, one bag of cutlery (spoons, knives, forks), one roll-up mat which includes a pillow and blanket for rest time (these can be purchased from J. C. Penney and other stores), and one canvas tote bag with handles (no zippers). A tote bag is required in preschool (no book bags).

KINDERGARTEN

Supplies for kindergarteners: two packs of **EIGHT COUNT PACKAGE OF CLASSIC CRAYOLA CRAYONS**, one package of **CLASSIC CRAYOLA BROAD TIP MARKERS**, five glue sticks, one package of No. 2 pencils, two boxes of Kleenex tissues, one dry erase marker (black/blue), one roll of paper towels, boys need to bring one container of Clorox wipes, girls need to bring one bottle of liquid antibacterial soap, one package of rectangular hand erasers (pink/white), and one canvas tote bag with handles or a book bag. We prefer no wheeled book bags. Kindergarteners are not required to carry excessive weight to justify wheels.

FIRST GRADE

Supplies for first graders: Two dozen #2 pencils (not mechanical), scissors, four glue sticks (.77 large size), two packages of pink "pearl" rectangular erasers (not pencil toppers), a 12" ruler with centimeter side, two primary journals by Mead Stage 3 (space for picture and ruled lines), Crayola washable markers, a package of dry erase markers, two boxes of crayons (8), a clip board, one container of Clorox wipes, one large box of Kleenex, a plastic storage box for school supplies (at least 8-12" x 5-1/4"), one stretchy jumbo book cover, one package of colored pencils, and one box of small envelopes (to be kept at home for sending money). Please label all items with child's name.

SECOND GRADE

Supplies for second graders: Scissors (Fiskar — blunt tip), three packages of regular No. 2 pencils, one box of crayons (24 count), two glue sticks, three packages of wide-ruled notebook paper, and three stretchy jumbo book covers. Girls need to bring two boxes of Clorox wipes, and boys need to bring two boxes of Kleenex tissues. We will not be using Trapper Keepers or 3-ring binders. Please label all school supplies with student's name.

THIRD GRADE

Supplies for third grade include: School box to store supplies, notebook—3-ring binder, notebook paper (wide ruled), one package of divider tabs, a package of No. 2 pencils, three stretchy jumbo book covers, one package of rectangular hand erasers, one subject 70 sheet spiral notebook (wide-ruled) for a journal, one pocket folder (no prongs), one large package of red ball-point pens, two dry erase markers (black), one large box of Kleenex, scissors (not blunt point), crayons (24 count), markers (no Sharpies), two small glue sticks, and one container of wet wipes. Please label all items with child's name.

FOURTH GRADE

Supplies for fourth grade include: Small assignment notebook, a zippered 3-ring binder notebook, a package of subject dividers labeled—Homework, Reading, Math, and Social Studies, one container of Clorox/Lysol wipes, hand sanitizer, notebook paper (wide ruled), one two-pocket folder without metal clips, one large box of Kleenex, a ruler (standard/metric), a box of crayons—any size, markers, two writing pens (any color), small scissors, book covers, a package of No. 2 pencils (please, no mechanical pencils), one glue stick, one subject spiral notebooks for science and spelling, one highlighter (any color), and a school box to store supplies.

FIFTH GRADE

Supplies for fifth grade include: A zippered Trapper Keeper or velcro closure notebook with six pocket dividers, notebook paper (wide ruled), No. 2 pencils, two highlighters, one box of colored pencils, two glue sticks in a Ziploc bag, one large box of Kleenex,

scissors, book covers, and two dry erase markers to give to the homeroom teacher. Please label all school supplies with student's name.

ENRICHMENT CLASSES

Music: Third through fifth grade students need a black dry erase marker with no names on them. They will be placed in a large container and will be used as they are needed.

Art: All students will need to bring a pack of No. 2 pencils and pink "pearl" erasers for art. Fourth graders need a 3-ring binder and a box of plastic sleeves to put their artwork in. Fifth graders need a composition notebook.

Computer: All students need to bring a pair of earbuds (new or used) in a Ziploc bag, labeled with the child's name, to be kept in computer class throughout the year.
