Orangeburg Prep is accredited by AdvancED and the South Carolina Independent School Association (SCISA). The school's other affiliations include the Southern Association in Independent Schools (SAIS), the National Association of Secondary School Principals (NAASP), and the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD).

**ORANGEBURG PREP HIGHLIGHTS:** 685 students in Pre K—12th grades, approximately 100 faculty and staff, Child Development Center, Student Center (peer tutoring program), forty-two athletic teams, two campuses, two gyms, two libraries, award-winning Fine Arts Department, academic clubs, civic clubs, special interests clubs, and speech / resource services.

## Class of 2017 Facts & Comparisons

**CLASS OF 2017:** The thirty-eight graduating seniors of the Class of 2016 perpetuate Orangeburg Prep's legacy of academic excellence. **Fourteen** students were recognized by the South Carolina Independent School Association as SCISA Honor Graduates for having scored at least 1100 on the SAT and obtaining a 3.5 grade point average for each of seven semesters. And, **twelve** students graduated with high honors which means they have a cumulative grade point average of 4.0 or higher, while **fourteen** students earned Life Scholarship. Furthermore, Orangeburg Prep has **three** students receiving the Palmetto Fellows Award. To receive the Palmetto a student must score at least 1200 on the SAT or 27 on the ACT, earn a cumulative 3.5 GPA, and rank in the top six percent of their class. A student who is not in the top six percent of his/her class may earn the Palmetto by scoring either 1400 on the SAT or 32 on the ACT and earn a cumulative 4.0 GPA. Among colleges and universities that our graduates will attend are Charleston Southern University, Clemson Bridge, Clemson University, Coastal Carolina, College of Charleston, EF Foreign Language Center (Beijing), Midlands Tech, Newberry College, Orangeburg Calhoun Technical College, Presbyterian College, South Carolina State University, The Citadel, Tri-County Technical College, United States Military Academy West Point, University of South Carolina, USC Beaufort, University of South Carolina Honors, and the University of South Carolina Upstate.
